

## Festive Foliage Card (Stampin' Blends)

### Supplies:

#### Cardstock/Paper:

- 1-Piece 5 ½" x 8 ½" Evening Evergreen cardstock, scored at 4 ¼"
- 1-Piece 3 ¾" x 4 ¾" Designer Series Paper (Tidings of Christmas)
- 1-Piece 3 ½" x 4 ½" Basic White cardstock

#### Inks/Coloring:

- Memento in Tuxedo Black
- Evening Evergreen Classic Stampin' Pad
- Soft Succulent Classic Stampin' Pad
- Stampin' Blends (Evening Evergreen, Soft Succulent, Misty Moonlight, Mint Macaron, Real Red)

#### Stamp Set/Dies/Embellishments/Tools/Adhesives:

- Festive Foliage stamp
- Evergreen Elegance Stamp Set
- Painted Labels Dies
- Label Me Fancy Punch
- Real Red Ruffled Ribbon
- Trimmer
- Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine
- Snips
- Stampin' Seal
- Stampin' Dimensionals
- Glue dots

#### Directions:

1. Stamp Festive Foliage image on Basic White cardstock in Memento Tuxedo Black ink, and color image using Stampin' Blends. Adhere this piece centered to the DSP panel.
2. Stamp sentiment in Evening Evergreen on scrap of Basic White – stamp pine boughs in Soft Succulent. Cut this out using a die from the Painted Labels die set. Punch holes on either end of this piece using the Label Me Fancy punch.
3. Feed an 8 inch length of the ruffled ribbon through these hole. Using Dimensionals, adhere the sentiment to the center of the Festive Foliage/DSP panel. Secure the edges of the ribbon to the back of the panel using Stampin' Seal. Then adhere this whole piece to the card base.
4. I tied a bow with the ruffled ribbon and adhered to the left of the sentiment using a glue dot – I positioned the hanging lengths of the ribbon ends with glue dots so as not to obscure the sentiment.
